

CAMPING

LEADER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Ensure noise curfew is kept – wind down from 10pm and all noise to end at 11pm.
- Monitor campfire and extinguish at 11pm.
- Ensuring the site is kept clean.
- Communicating to those staying at the site in your group.
- Communicate issues with StayKCC staff or Convention Coordinator.

WHAT TO BRING TO KYCK

- Tent and camping gear
- Food
- Torch, light or gas lantern

ARRIVAL

The camp site will be available from 3.00pm to peg in or plug in.

Bush care: Please ask your group to use the gates rather than go through new fences. Also ask them to use the paths rather than “bush bash” to KYCK.

Remind your group:

- Wind down from 10pm and quiet at 11.00pm - for the neighbours’ sake as well as other campers.
- Total fire-ban, if applied, means no naked flames.

- The central shelter is for communal use. Please be COVID sensible and don't leave supplies or cooking utensils in the central shelter. Use hand sanitiser before and after using the central shelter.
- Most cars must be parked outside the camping ground if there is not enough room – please park on the Oval NOT the surrounding streets.
- All holes and trenches dug must be filled in before leaving.
- Enforce the rules for youth (especially no alcohol), patrolling at night as required.

CAMPFIRE SPECIFIC RULES

This year, we're organising 2 drum fires for campers at KYCK. These will be located where there is room, probably around the central shelter.

1. Subject to weather conditions. StayKCC will cancel if unsafe.
2. Site host is to manage the campfire and ensure that noise levels are kept moderate.
3. Site host to extinguish fire at 11pm each night.
4. KCC will reserve the right to extinguish the campfire if the above is not adhered to (this would be done in consultation with the site host)

THROUGHOUT THE WEEKEND

- Please note that when KCC's campground is not in use for private events, the campground is open for independent campers, and often we have tourists arriving. If some of these campers arrive hoping to camp, please politely explain that the campground is closed for a private event – as per the sign at the gate (and this is also explained on various online platforms). If you need assistance, don't hesitate to call property staff on 0408 825 588.

- Give any lost property to the KCC Information Tent.
